

Where do I find the degree and program information that should appear on a student's title page?

This information is found in SGASTDN. The program name and concentration (if any) will be listed under "Field of Study". Only concentrations listed here may be included on the title page. If there is no concentration listed here, there should be no concentration on the title page.
